Playgroups (Ages 3-5)

Socialization activities are facilitated within our small group setting to target: turn taking, interacting, cooperating, and attending to an activity and building self-esteem.

Social Skills Groups (Ages 5-13)

Specific areas of concentration include friendship skills, cooperation, self-regulation, perspective taking, and emotion management although the specific goals targeted will be determined by the needs of the children within the group.

Teaching Social Skills w/ LEGO®

(Ages 5-18) While working collaboratively with others on Lego® projects, children will learn the following: working together, communicating effectively with others, eye contact, problem solving, establishing friendships, compromising, and anger management.

ADD it Up! Social Skills Group

(ages 6-12) Get Focused on the Solutions! This class for children with ADD/HD and/or behavioral challenges will focus on activities that stress interaction and cooperation. Board games, building projects, role-play, and hands on activities will be utilized to provide the greatest opportunity for learning appropriate social skills and controlling impulsivity.

STRIKE! Teenage Social Skills Group

(Ages 13-19) Designed to prepare young adults to manage the pressures of social situations in high school, college, or on the job. This group concentrates on working collaboratively with others on a project and the primary focus includes compromising and negotiating with others, accepting rejected ideas, communicating effectively with others, conversational skills, eye contact, problem solving, establishing friendships, and anger management.

Adult Social Skills Group (Ages 20+)

Preparation for more independent living is essential for adults to become productive members of society. Our groups will target interpersonal communication skills, peer socialization, daily living skills, employment success strategies, and other areas necessary for living a fulfilling life. Groups will be tailored to meet the participant's unique needs.

Peer Buddies: Developing Essential Communication Skills

For those who are non-verbal or have limited verbal abilities. Each individual will be paired with an age appropriate partner who will work closely with a Behavior Consultant and/or Speech Therapist to develop communication through multiple modalities and social interaction through fun activities. Pairings will be developed as appropriate peers are enrolled.
