Summer ABA Services

This summer, are you looking for additional opportunities for your child to acquire new skills and/or reduce challenging behaviors? Interactive Kids will design a program based upon your child's unique needs in the following areas:

- Administration of the *Assessment of Basic Language and Learning Skills – Revised (ABLLS-R)* to identify areas to be targeted for instruction
- Individual academic instruction, using a verbal behavior and discrete trial approach, which involves:
 - breaking a skill into smaller parts
 - teaching one sub-skill at a time until mastery
 - allowing repeated practice in a concentrated period of time
 - prompting and prompt fading as necessary
 - expanding communication skills
 - utilizing reinforcement procedures
- Functional Communication Training
- Individual social skills instruction
- Implementation of intervention strategies for behavior specific targets (i.e. accepting no, waiting, attending to task/focusing, transitions from preferred to non-preferred activities, etc).
- Generalization of skills to the natural environment
- Functional Behavior Assessment at our clinic and/or the natural environment
- Positive Behavior Support (PBS) that promotes adaptive behavior in conjunction with problem behavior reduction through the implementation of individual behavior plans
- Toilet training
